Dave recently received the following correspondence from winners of 160-meter plaques sponsored by club members and SEDXC.

Dear Dave and SEDXC Assoc.

Thanks so very much for the beautiful plaque I received recently for winning the USA in the 1988 CQ 160 meter SSB contest. Getting such a great looking plaque makes all the hard work worthwhile. The present 160 set up here is a 160' base insulated series fed vertical tower, which I also use on 80 as a 5/8 wave. For receiving I have a choice of 8 beverages terminated of course. 7 are 1000' long and 1,600'. Also a 1/2 wave dipole at 30'. A 1/2 wave @ 140' on another tower serves as a horizontal and back-up antenna.....

Dave thanks again for sponsoring the plaque, also the best of 1989 to you the SEDX Assoc.
