TREASURER's Report –February, 2026

The checkbook Balance on February 19, 2026 - \$8,131.69

1. Payments made – month of January 2026
 - a. Georgia Secretary of State filing = \$40
 - b. CYØS DXpedition funding support = \$250
2. Donations received (to date, through December 31 2025) \$770.41

Remember we are now a 501©3 organizations and can accept donations of cash and/or estate equipment, or be included in your estate planning.

At our upcoming meeting on Thursday, February 19th at 7PM we will discuss the funding request received from Philipp Springer, DK6SP to support the upcoming S21WD Bangladesh DXpeditions. This activation will be from March 20th thru April 1, 2026. The team consists of DK6SP & Sven, DJ4MX as co-leads and 4 other operators. Note with the exception of Anup, S21TV, all other operators are in their 20's – a youth DXpedition!

Globally, S2 is Most Wanted #93 & North America -East Coast it is #33.

QSLs via DJ4MX & ClubLog OQRS (approx. 4 Euro) & free of charge bureau. Also full & free LoTW upload ongoing during the DXpedition if wifi is available and shortly after returning if not.

Overall budget for event is Euro 47,000.

A review of our Club members' needs from a sample of 25 of our Club Leagues' participants indicates that this will be an ATNO for 14 & for those having confirmed S2 on only 1 or 2 bands another 8. The rest of the sample would benefit from band fills.

The EC recommends a gift of \$500.

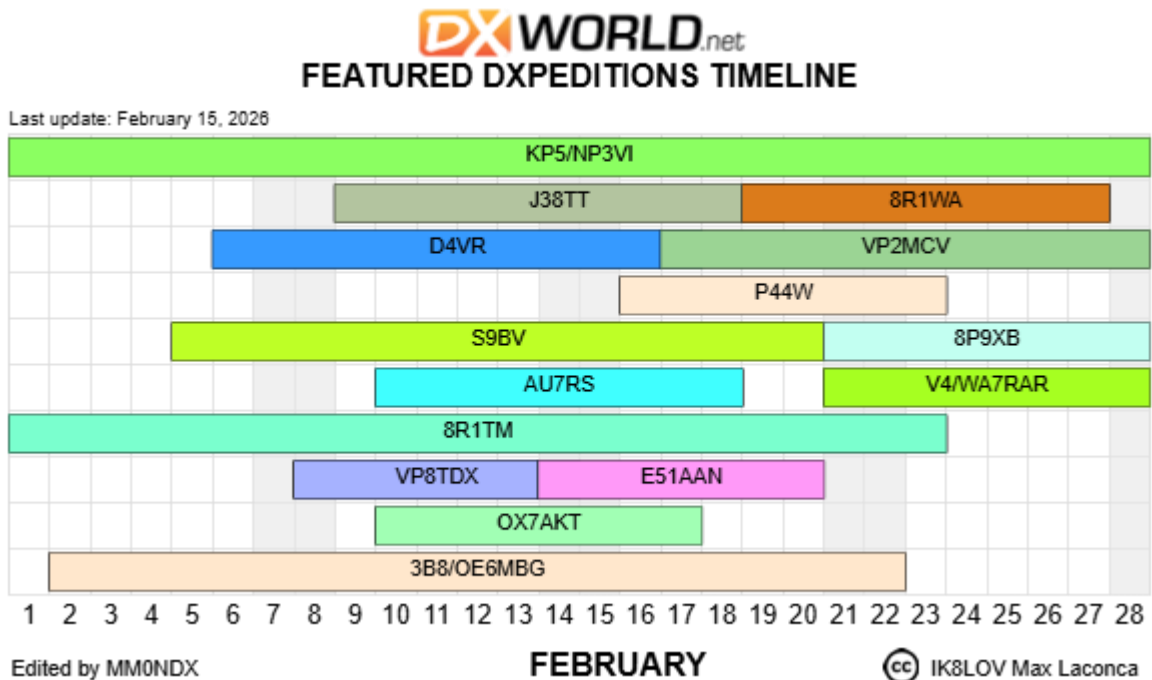
