1987 SOUTHEASTERN DX CLUB ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM de K4JRB:

The Club Achievement Program consists of three parts...

1. Quarterly Open Contests with a plaque to the winner and special gifts to the runner-ups.
2. Participation in ARRL and CQ WW Contests.
3. Regular Club and Special Event attendance.

The OVERALL WINNER will get a plaque and the DXpedition trip! This year the Contest Committee will pick the winner based on a points system. The object is to enter every Quarterly contest, be active in the ARRL and CQ WW contests, and attend club meetings (for locals) or DXPO/the ARRL National Convention for you out-of-towners and GOOD LUCK TO ALL!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

PART 1. QUARTERLY OPEN CONTESTS.

Quarter 1 (February and March). Most DXCC Countries on 20 meters any 48 hour weekend. Excludes ARRL and CQ WPX Weekends. Results due April 15.

Quarter 2 (April and May). Most DXCC Countries on 15 Meters any 48 hour period. Results due June 15.

Quarter 3 (August and September). Most European DXCC Countries during the period including WAE too! Results due October 15.

Quarter 4 (November). Most Oceania DXCC Countries worked excluding CQ WW CW. Results due December 15.

As in past years the winners are excluded from Plaque Competition after winning one contest. The points continue to add up so keep on aiming at the overall prize!

PART 2. ARRL AND CQ WW CONTESTS.

Contests include ARRL DX, CQ WW 160, and CQ WW (Fall). Points will be awarded for the following...

1. Entry
2. Official Club Entry (Credit to SEDXC).
3. Scoring well (Multi-band or Single).
4. Improving your score over last year.
5. Entering both phone and cw Sections.

Be sure to get your score to K4JRB and we'll do the figuring!!!!!!

PART 3. Attendance.

This is easy...just attend meetings on a regular basis! DXPO and/or the ARRL National Convention counts for you out of town members.

The Contest Committee adds up the points and awards the prizes. Be sure to enter so you won't get a call from the Committee (Tar and Feathers??).
