### NF20 LOSES TOWER CASE:

In a ruling on April 10<sup>th</sup> Norm Friedman lost his bid to install a tower in excess of 35 ft. at his home in Cobb county.

The judge ruled that the 35 ft. ordinance was constitutional and that Norm's rights as an amateur were not being unconstitutionally restricted by the 35 ft. tower limitation. He was given 60 days to bring his tower into compliance or appeal. Norm was also fined over \$2000.00. He will appeal.

This could spell disaster for all the DX'ers in Cobb County if it is not overturned on appeal. We should have more news at the meeting. Be there and find out what needs to be done. We might start thinking of a "War Chest" to defend our rights to keep our towers up where we can "Work the Rare Ones".
