W4FX, CLAYTON "RIP" MERRELL OF ANDERSON, SOUTH CAROLINA RECEIVED A NICE AWARD. HE WAS THE WINNER OF THE 1989 ROANOAK DIVISION ARRL SERVICE AWARD FOR SOUTH CAROLINA, NORTH CAROLINA, VIRGINIA AND WEST VIRGINIA FOR HIS DEDICATED SERVICE ON HEHALF OF HAM RADIO.

THE AWARD WAS PRESENTED TO HIM IN CHARLOTTE AT THE HAMFEST BY JOHN KANODE, N4MM.

HE WAS FIRST LICENSED IN 1937 AS W4EDA AND LATER CHANGED HIS CALL TO W4FX. HE GRADUATED FROM AUBURN UNIVERSITY IN 1941. MOST OF HIS CAREER WAS SPENT WITH A.T. & T. LONG LINES. HE SERVED WITH THE U. S. NAVY AS LT. COMMANDER.

HE IS A MEMBER OF THE NCDXX, SEDXC AND CDXA. HE IS ALSO AN ARRL LIFE MEMBER AND HAS BEEN A MEMBER OF THE ARRL SINCE 1936.

HE IS A CREDITED VE EXAMINER, ARRL AWARDS MANAGER AND IS INTERESTED IN EMERGENCY WORK. HE WAS VERY ACTIVE DURING HURRICANE HUGO. HE IS VERY INTERESTED IN ANTENNAS, DX, STRONG IN PACKET AND 160 METERS.
