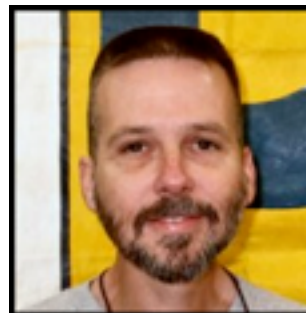
Veep's Report

Chris is a seasoned and respected defense lawyer. He has represented public entity clients from Valdosta to LaFayette and from Columbus to Augusta. His private clients have sent him around the world in defense of claims. He served his country with distinction in the United States Marine Corps, receiving his Honorable Discharge in 1993. He was awarded the Good Conduct Medal and the Navy Achievement Medal in 1989. At the award ceremony for the Navy Achievement Medal, Brigadier General Brabham remarked he had not ever heard a more detailed or deserving citation.

Chris is admitted to the bar of the United States Supreme Court, the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit, the United States District Courts for the Middle and Northern Districts of Georgia, the Georgia Supreme Court, the Georgia Court of Appeals, and the Trial Courts in Georgia.
