SEDXC MEETING HELD 05/18/93

The May meeting of the SEDXC was called to order at 7:30 PM by President Larry Flegle, N4TMW. After introductions by everyone, several items concerning financial aid to DXpeditions were discussed. There will be a group going to Mellish in September or October. Financial assistance will be needed. More details will be forthcoming. A motion was passed to provide up to \$250 in matching funds for the 5A, Libya operation. Contributions should be given to Dave, K4JRB.

There will be a vote at the May meeting on an addition to the Bylaws to require that within 60 days of election of new officers, an updated membership roster must be distributed to the membership.

Larry presented a slate of proposed officers from the nominating committee. The nominees were:

The position of Historian would be filled by the immediate past president. This was also approved by acclamation.

Jim, N4UCK gave a report on packet cluster and tower ordinance activity. Progress is well under way on repairing the backbone operation thanks to the contributions from everyone. Also, thanks to Jim's efforts, Bill Barr was presented with a building permit for his tower. Jim reported that now in Fulton county, there is no longer any discretion in the tower process if the proper procedure is followed. Many thanks to Jim and Bill for their efforts in the tower issue.

Jim, W4QO reported on efforts to have an amateur radio station at Scitrek. Hopefully, it will be brought into operation in the fall. He indicated he would like for the club to send a representative to a June 17 meeting on the subject. He and Larry are to discuss this further.

Following the business portion of the meeting, Carl and Martha Henson presented a super program on the Ethiopian and Eritrean operations. Carl indicated he was still working to have the Eritrean operation count although initial indications are that it may not. Regardless of the outcome, many thanks to Carl and Martha for the many new and rare ones they have provided to us over the years.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 PM.

It has been an interesting month so far. 9MØS just went off the air, E3 just came on, and a DL/portable T5 has been hanging around. I worked the 9MØS one call, 100 watts, on 15m CW at noon Memorial Day. Surprised me considering the fairly large pileups on SSB during the evenings. Haven't been able to crack the evening 20m pileups for the E3 yet. I hope Carl and Martha's cards for Eritria are good, the letter Carl sent to the DXAC was very convincing.

CQ WPX CW contest was interesting, worked a bunch of 40m CW contacts. Needed them towards the 5BDXCC award. Some very strange prefixes too. It's hard when you have to actually exchange some information! (for me, that is) Didn't hear the 9MØS during the contest but they picked up afterwards. My vertical on 40 and 80m works, but I envy those with a 40m beam. I remember the difference after getting a beam for 10,15, and 20m. 5 S units will make the difference between "can't hear at all" and "solid copy."

It's been a fun year and I hope to continue these columns next year. Maybe by then I'll get my Extra and REALLY explore some dark and murky depths in places like 14.005 and 7.005 MHz!
