EAST - Amateur Radio exams will be given each 2nd Saturday of the month at the Stone Mountain First United Methodist Church at 5312 West Mountain Street in Stone Mountain. The time will be 8:30 AM and the fee for the WALK-IN exam is \$4.00.

SOUTH - A group of SEDXC/DDXers are giving Amateur exams on the first Saturday of each month, excluding Holiday weekends, in Peachtree City at the City Hall Municipal Bldg. The time will be 8:00 AM and the fee for the WALK-IN exam is \$4.00.

DOWNTOWN - Amateur exams will be given by the ARRL VEC, on the Georgia Tech campus, on the 4th Sunday of the month. This is the only local AFTERNOON exams that I know of in the Atlanta Area. 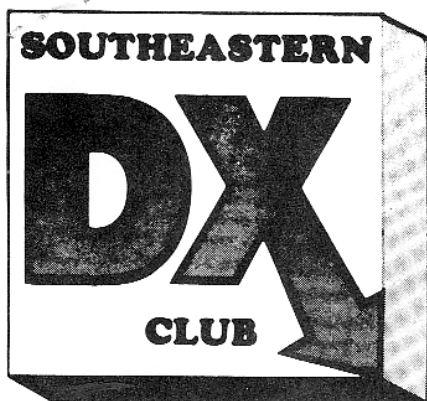
