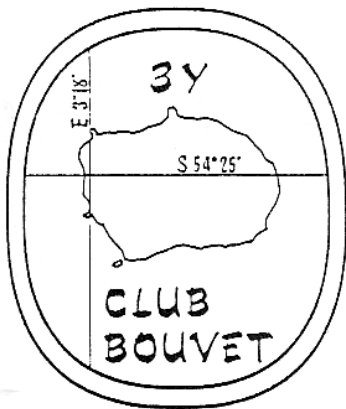

Expedition to Bouvetøya 1989/90

News Release #2
Oslo 14 August 1989

15 September is deadline to charter ship with helicopter.

All DXers, Foundations, Clubs, Groups and Associations wishing to give their support are urged to do so well in advance of that date, for the expedition to go ahead as planned. Use either a) Green stamps (any value) in envelope as registered mail or b) International Postal Money Order or c) Visa or d) International Cheque in Norwegian currency (NOK) or e) Personal cheque.

We are very impressed by the 90 DXers in 14 countries having taken immediate action. Some individuals have generously contributed 5000\$ and 1000\$ each. One of these even has Bouvetøya confirmed! Others have contributed the equivalent of 250\$ or smaller amounts. Comments received show that all share our common spirit of excitement, joy and determination. As every year, several groups are now reported to be thinking about operating from Bouvetøya in 1990. Club Bouvet is in contact with two such groups. No one has obtained the necessary approvals for an expedition in 1990. We do not think there is going to be more than one expedition.

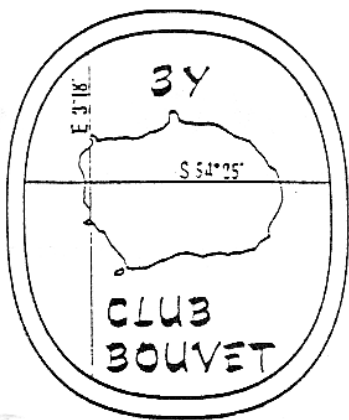

We are writing to you to ask for support from South Eastern DX Club for the Club Bouvet expedition to Bouvetøya in December. We enclose News Release #2 (and #1 if we did not send it to you earlier).


The purpose of this exiting mission is to create activity and to give as many radio amateurs as possible world wide a new country, hopefully on several bands, including 6m and 160 m. The two most recent operations at Bouvetøya were conducted by scientists who worked ham radio only in their spare time. This time hams will be dedicated to DX operation full time. The planned stay at the island is 2-3 weeks. There will be others on board who will engage in their own, separate non-ham activities and who, by their participation, will help finance the overall mission.

Club Bouvet shall do its utmost to give everyone an equal share of the fun, excitement and the chances of working a new one. We are working very hard now to secure the necessary funding and a suitable vessel with a crew experienced in Antarctic operations.

We rely heavily on the support of interested foundations, clubs, groups and individuals. A contribution from South Eastern DX Club would be particularly welcome. In some instances it seems that individuals like to get their own personal membership in Club Bouvet in addition to the participation by the group to which they belong.

As time is running short, we would urge you to take quick action. We look forward to hearing from you soon.
