3C1, EQUATORIAL GUINEA. Joe, K8JP, QSL Manager for Ed, 3C1TR, informed OPDXB that Ed will be leaving September 11th. He also mentioned Ed will be trying to be active on the lower HF bands and WARC bands before leaving. Check 3790 kHz around 0135z and 7180-84 kHz around 0500z. Also listen to the 21355 DX net around 1500z.

5H, TANZANIA. Christoph, HB9HAL, will be active the next 5 weeks from here. He was to receive his licence upon his arrival September 1st, but there has not been any QSN reports on his activity as of yet. 8X, INDIA. A station was reported signing 8X8JA on September 2nd on 14003 kHz between 0030 and 0100z. The operator gave his QTH as Calcutta, bureau).

BV, TAIWAN. BV2EL, was heard this week (Sept. 1 and 2) begging for contacts on 21255 kHz around 0100z. Also, one of these stations: BV2BI, BV3CV, BV4CT, BV4MK, BV4OB, BV7FC can be found almost daily on 20 meter CW from 1200-1400z.

C2, NAURU. JA2NQG, JI2UAY and JH2BNL will be active from here September 8-12. Operations will be on 160-6 meters CW/SSB/FM. Their call signs and QSL information was not mentioned.

C56, THE GAMBIA. The members of Central Arizona DX Association (CADXA), Mike/AA7NO, Warren/KF7AY and Tony/N7BG will be signing C56V from the capital city of Banjul for the CQWW SSB Contest (Oct. 30-31). Outside the contest they will be active as C56/(home call), and plan to be active on CW/SSB, 80-10 meters, including WARC bands. Tentative dates for the operation is October 28th thru November 3rd. QSL Contest QSO's go via KD7E, Gary McClellan, 3422 E. Altadena Ave., Phoenix, AZ, 85028-2010 and all contacts made outside the contest go via the operator's CBA.

FR/J, JUAN DE NOVA. It was reported on the French DX Net by LU2NI that FR5ZQ was heard signing / J. It was indicated that he was heard on 21171 kHz at 1600z and 14147 kHz at 1700z, August 30th. FR5ZQ's length of stay is unknown at this time.

SV/A MOUNT ATHOS. The VK2SG RTTY Notes reported this week that SV2ASP/A made only six demonstration QSOs on RTTY, two of which were with IK5KKW and PA0HVF. UPDATED: Just before print, OPDXB received information about Monk Apollo. Someone reported on the INDEXA net that an AMTOR

DX Bulletin stated SV2WT said Apollo, SV2ASP/A, will become active again. His time will be limited due to work being done on one of the monasteries. Also, the station is being relocated to another hilltop. Apollo has also applied for a new call sign for next year (possibly SYØA). Begin listening for him on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays between 0600-1200z. It was stated that he would show on OE6EEG DX Net on 21205 kHz on Saturdays and Sundays. There is a possibility that he may also show on Fridays on the 21335 DX Net with Denny, GW3CDP.
