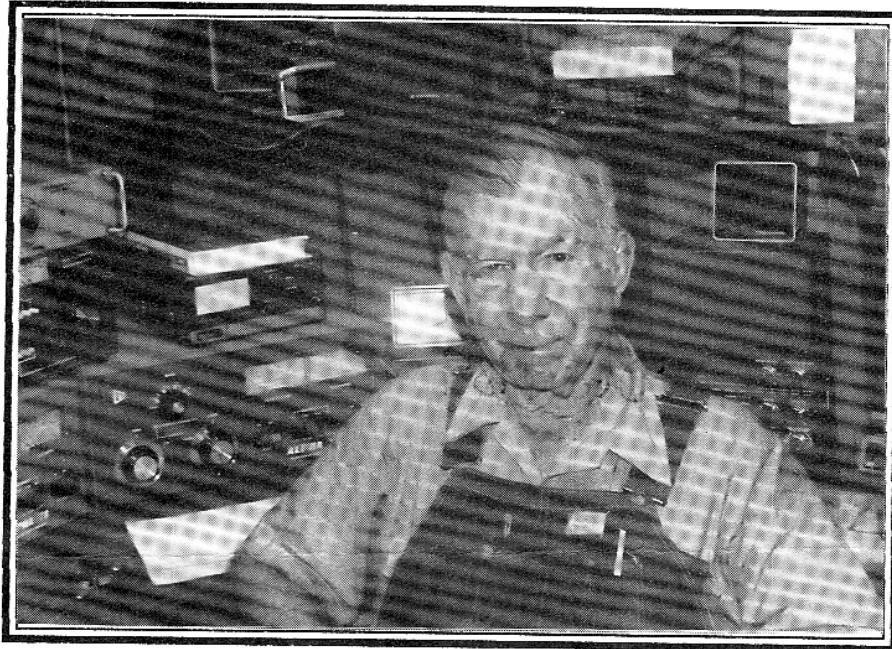
After the break the meeting resumed and there was no new business.
